



SCAVENGER HUNT

PACIFIC SOUTHWEST CONFERENCE 2015

OBJECTIVE

- ◆ To encourage teamwork and underclassmen participation

PARTICIPANT RULES

- ◆ Each school may enter one team only.
- ◆ Each team must consist of at least 2 members.
- ◆ Each team member must be a registered participant of the PSWC 2015.
- ◆ Each team must have at least one underclassman.
- ◆ Each team must have a designated captain.

EVENT DESCRIPTION

The Scavenger Hunt will begin on Thursday, April 9th, 2015 at 8:00am and end on Saturday, April 11th, 2015 at 12:00pm. Teams will work together to complete as many tasks as possible on the Scavenger Hunt List in order to earn as most points as possible.

GENERAL RULES

1. Teams must download the Scavenger Hunt List between 8:00 am and 8:30 am on Thursday, April 9th, 2015 from the PSWC 2015 app or online at PSWC2015.weebly.com.
2. The Scavenger Hunt List will have various tasks; each task will be assigned a task number.
3. Teams should try to complete as many tasks as possible.
4. Teams are required to bring at least one digital camera. Teams will use the camera to take photos that clearly show each task was completed while representing your school.
5. Teams may submit only one photo per task. Each photo must be named in the following format "SCHOOL ABBREVIATION_TASK"





- NUMBER". For example: "UA_3" will be the filename for the photo the University of Arizona submits to show that they completed task 3 on the Scavenger Hunt List. All photos must be in JPEG format.
6. Teams must upload each photo to their school's designated folder in the Dropbox file, which will be sent out in Mailer 3. Be sure to test your Dropbox file to ensure your school's images get judged.
 7. Each team is responsible for joining the provided Dropbox folder.
 8. Any photos that are not correctly labeled will be deleted and not judged. Non-Scavenger Hunt material should not be included in the folder. Judges may refuse to check a submittal that is unorganized or confusing.
 9. It is the team's responsibility to ensure their submittal is in the correct/readable format.
 10. Teams may begin submitting their DropBox files at 8:00 am on Thursday, April 9th, 2015. Any submittals after 12:01 pm on Saturday, April 11th, 2015 will not be accepted.
 11. All final submittal deadlines/requirements will be printed on the Scavenger Hunt List. Further instructions and rules will also be printed on the Scavenger Hunt List.
 12. The time each team submits their files will be recorded for tiebreaker purposes. In the case of a tie, the team that turned their files into Dropbox earlier will be ranked higher.
